Get ready for the 2024 WWS Canada Cup, an electrifying professional cash prize jump & overall event coming to Saskatoon, Saskatchewan! Yes, you heard it right! Saskatoon Water Ski Club, Canada's oldest water ski club since 1972, is proud to host this prestigious event on August 28-29.

Our club, nestled in the heart of Saskatoon's industrial area, boasts a world-class facility thanks to a lake extension project initiated in 2014. Over the years, we've been privileged to welcome top-tier coaches and skiers, sparking discussions about hosting a pro water ski event. And now, it's finally happening!

In partnership with World Water Skiers and the Overall tour, our inaugural event promises thrilling action and top-notch competition. World's best overall skiers battle it out during the day and the World's best men's and women's jump events will dazzle audiences late into the evenings, ensuring a fantastic spectacle for all.

Here's what you can expect:

### Jump Format & Registration:

- Invitations extended to the top 15 men and top 10 women from;
- 2024 Waterski Pro Tour Leaderboard of June 10<sup>th</sup> (Post LA Night Jam);
- IWWF World List from June 10<sup>th</sup>;
- Open spots after **July 1<sup>st</sup>** will be filled by athletes further down the IWWF dynamic ranking list.
- No Entry refunds after Aug 1 - unless WWS injury rule is met [Rule #9](#)
- Athletes must update their WWS athlete profile before competing.
- Elimination rounds start- late afternoon of August 28th, following Overall prelims.
- Top 6 men and top 3 women will advance to the finals on August 29th.
- A Last Chance Qualifier (LCQ) round on the morning of August 29th, with 2 men and 2 women joining the finalists.
- Top 3 Men's Jumpers from the Elimination Round will compete for Jump Off Cash Prize on Tuesday evening following the elimination round. Each Jumper will have 2 jumps. The top 2 Jumpers will advance to the Jump Off Cash Prize\* which will be 1 jump only.
- Finals featuring 8 men and 5 women, late afternoon of August 29th.
- Amateur jump event on both days, running before Overall Events

### Overall Format & Registration:

- Invitations extended to the top 10 men and top 10 women on the WWS ranking list.
- Open spots after **July 1<sup>st</sup>** will be filled by athletes further down the IWWF dynamic ranking list.
- No Entry refunds after Aug 1 - unless WWS injury rule is met [Rule #9](#)
- Athletes must update their WWS athlete profile before competing.
- Elimination round midday on August 28th, followed by jump prelims.
- Top 5 men and 4 women will advance to the finals at midday on August 29th.

4. Amateur Jump Entry Fee - payable on registration by e-transfer or PayPal
